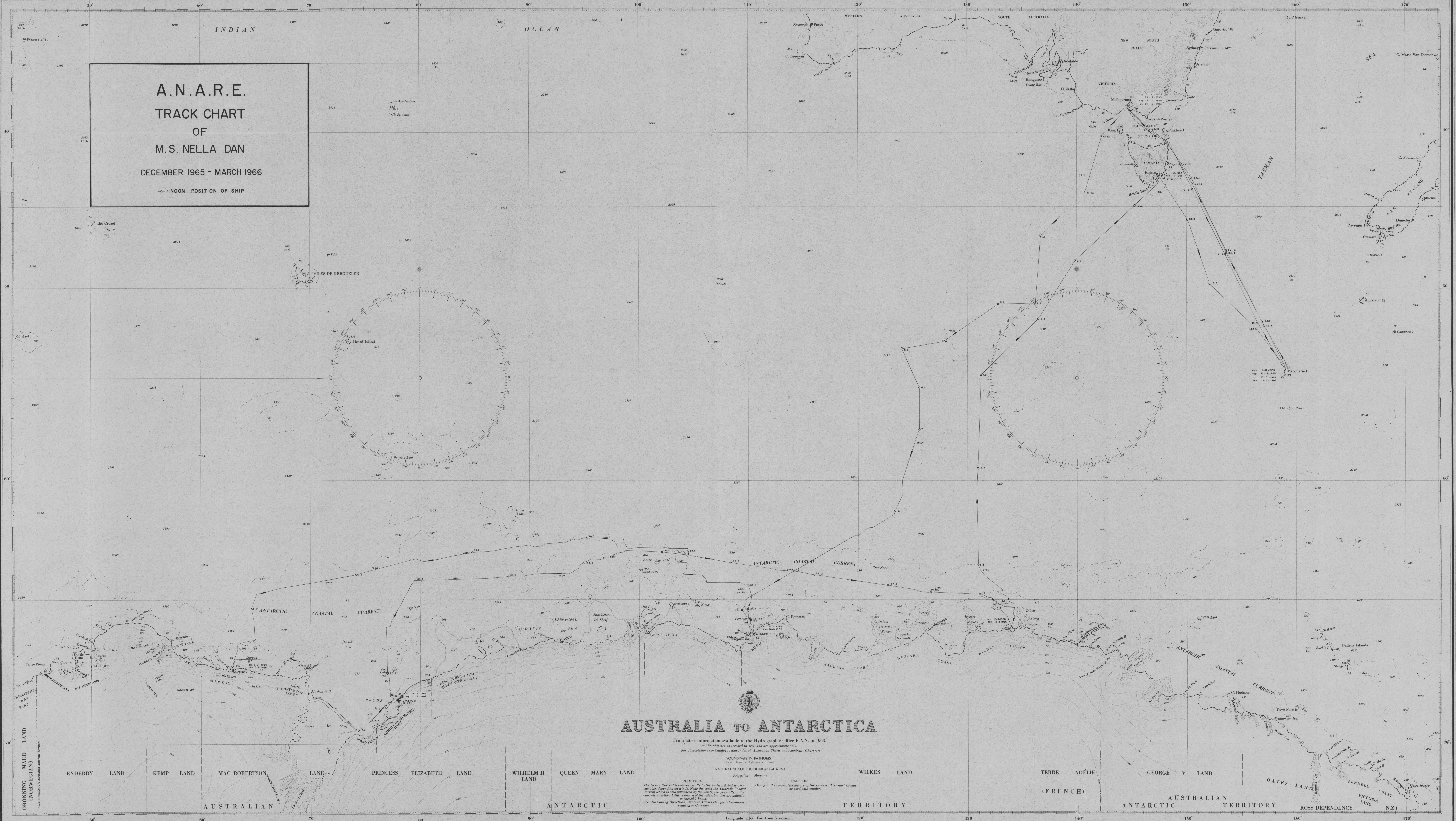


A.N.A.R.E. TRACK CHART OF M.S. NELLA DAN

CURRENTS
The Ocean Current trends generally to the eastward, but is very variable, depending on winds. Near the coast the Antarctic Coastal Current which is also influenced by the winds, sets generally in the opposite direction. Little is known of the rates, but they are unlikely to exceed 2 knots.
