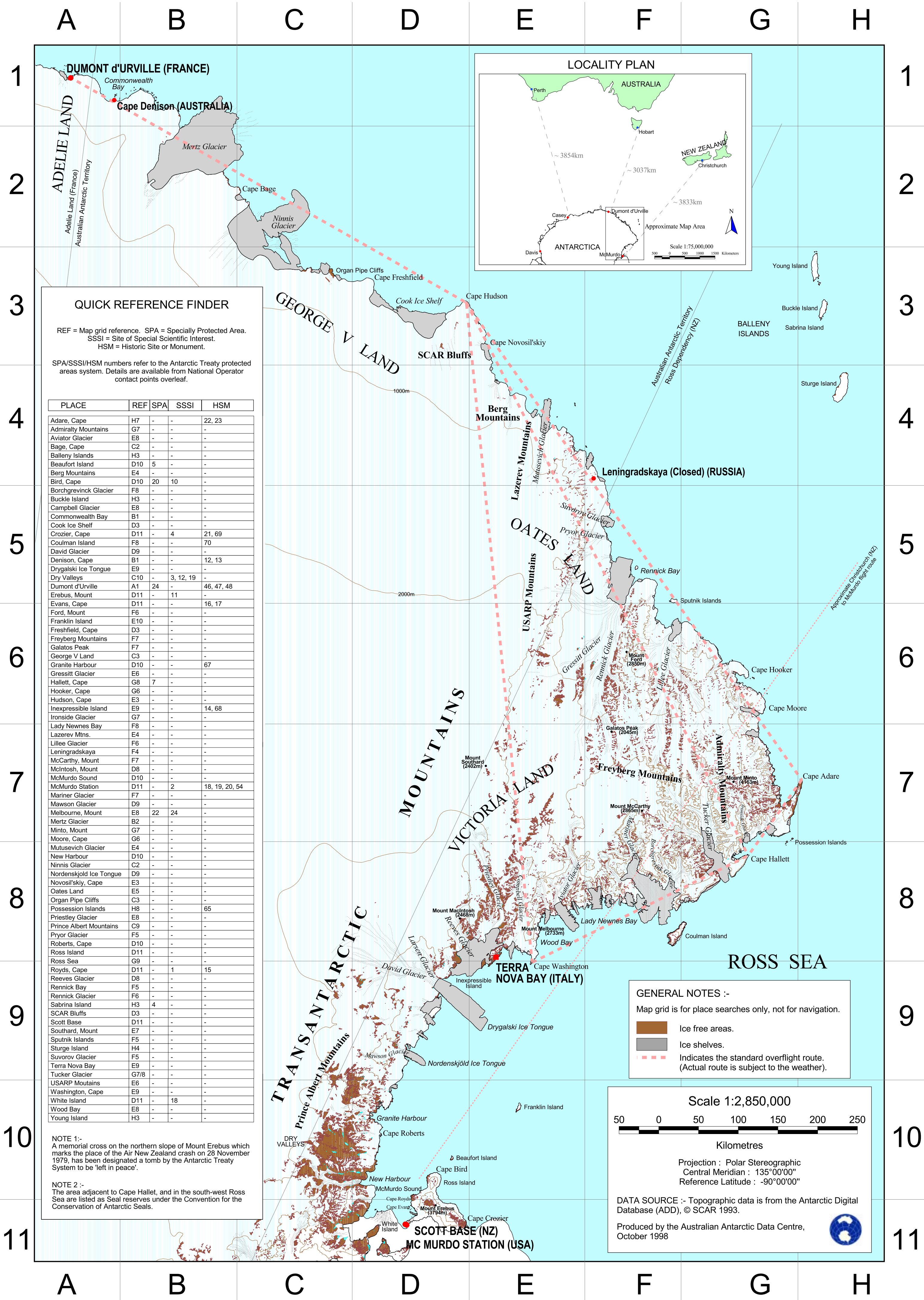


ANTARCTIC OVERFLIGHT ROUTE

SPA/SSSI/HSM numbers refer to the Antarctic Treaty protected areas system. Details are available from National Operator contact points overleaf.

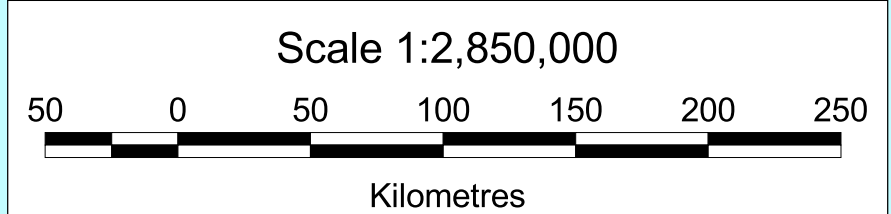

 A memorial cross on the northern slope of Mount Erebus which marks the place of the Air New Zealand crash on 28 November 1979, has been designated a tomb by the Antarctic Treaty System to be 'left in peace'.

 The area adjacent to Cape Hallett, and in the south-west Ross Sea are listed as Seal reserves under the Convention for the Conservation of Antarctic Seals.
