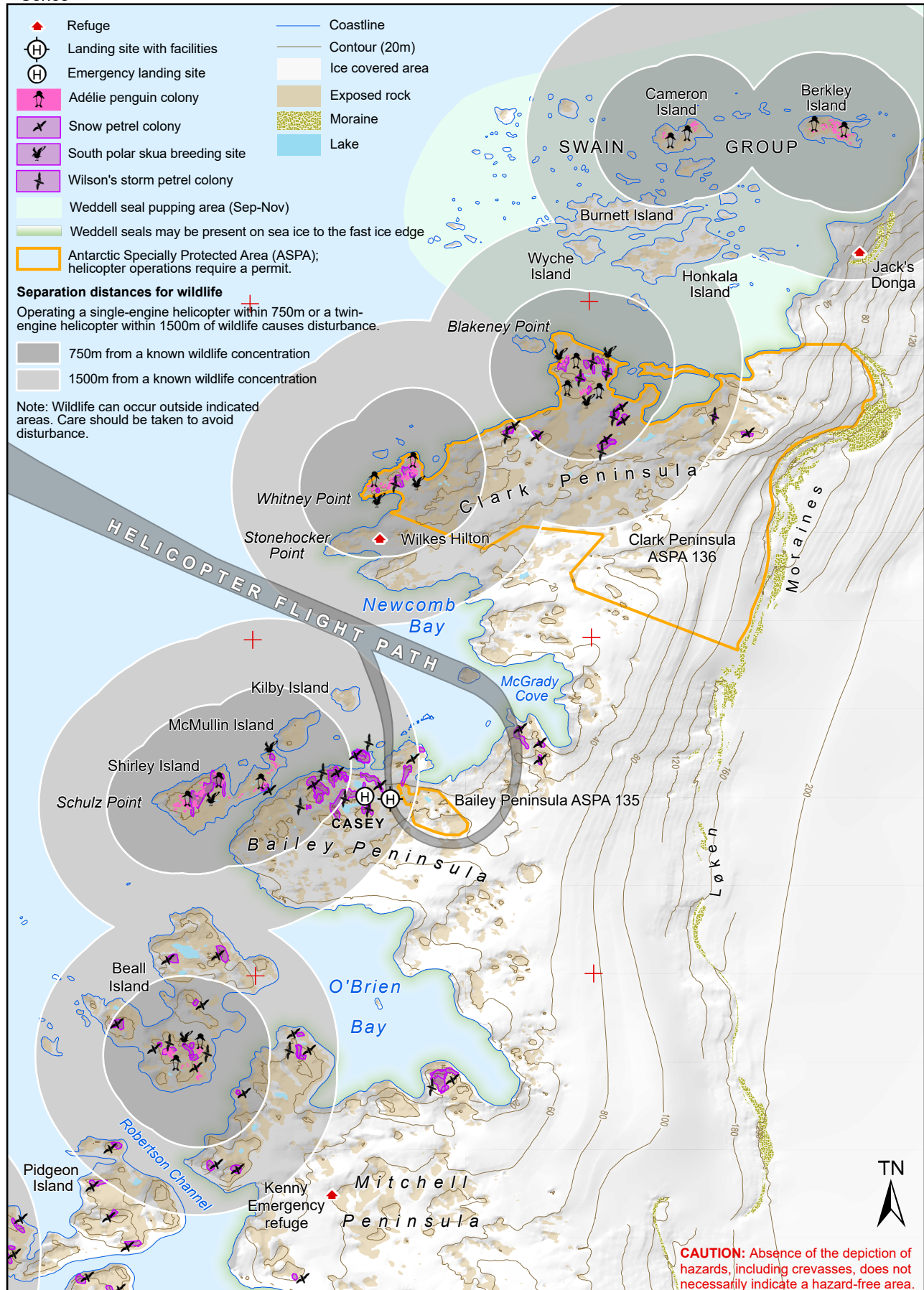
- Refuge
- Landing site with facilities
- Emergency landing site
- Adélie penguin colony
- Snow petrel colony
- South polar skua breeding site
- Wilson's storm petrel colony
- Weddell seal pupping area (Sep-Nov)
- Weddell seals may be present on sea ice to the fast ice edge
- Antarctic Specially Protected Area (ASPAs); helicopter operations require a permit.
- Coastline
- Contour (20m)
- Ice covered area
- Exposed rock
- Moraine
- Lake

Separation distances for wildlife

Operating a single-engine helicopter within 750m or a twin-engine helicopter within 1500m of wildlife causes disturbance.

- 750m from a known wildlife concentration
- 1500m from a known wildlife concentration

Note: Wildlife can occur outside indicated areas. Care should be taken to avoid disturbance.
