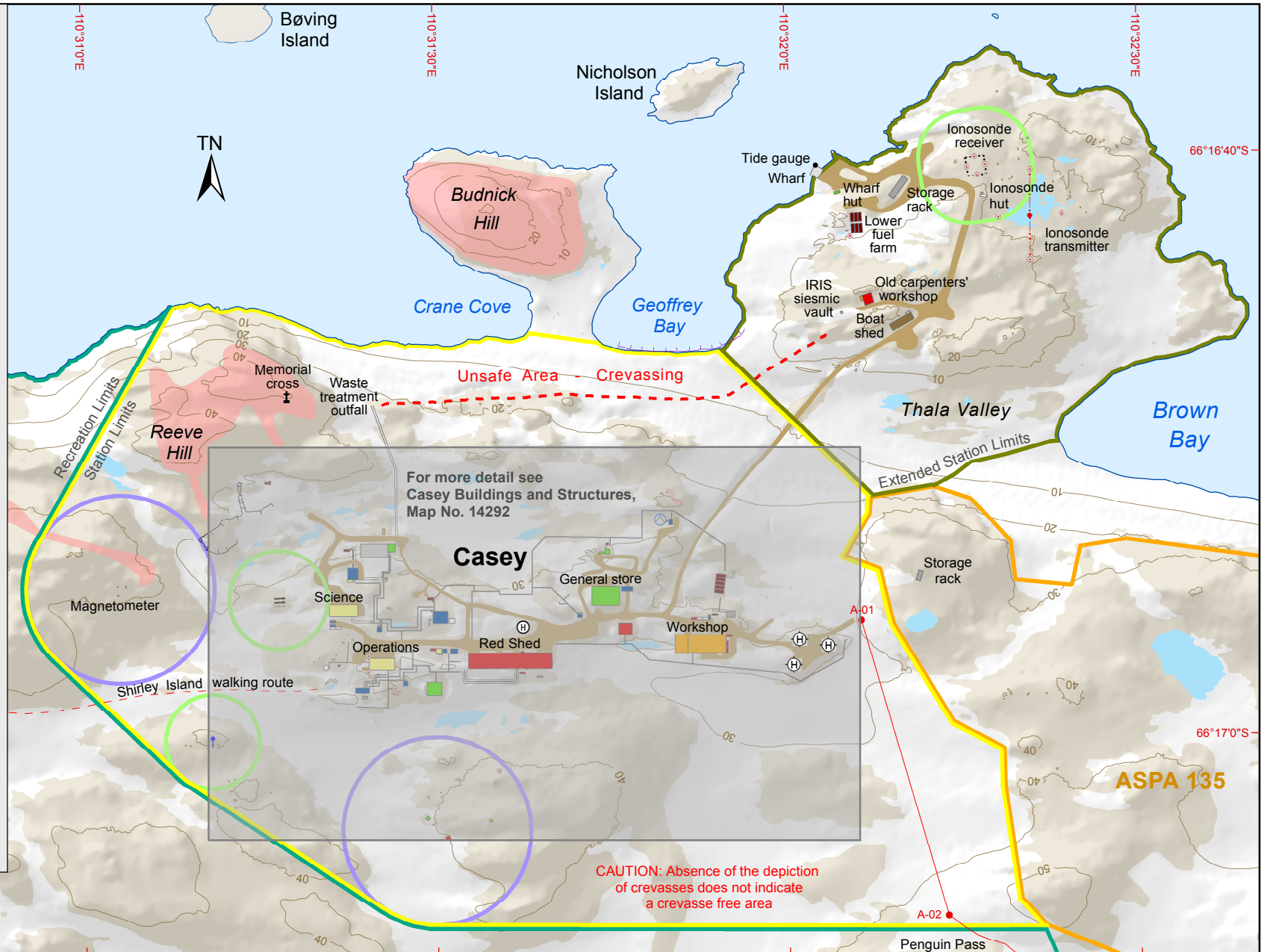
STATION LIMITS



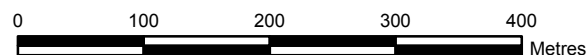

Legend

- Station Limits
Travel outside Station Limits requires Station Leader approval.
 - Extended Station Limits
A radio must be carried and the intentions board filled in when travelling to this area.
 - Recreation Limits
Travel permitted as per the AAD Operations Manual Vol 1 (Station and Field). Extreme caution should be taken as there are ice cliffs and rocky outcrops near the coastline and the sea ice between Shirley Island and the station is not permanent.
 - Magnetic Quiet Zone
Not to be entered without Station Leader approval.
 - Radio Frequency Interference Area
No transmitting devices to be switched on in this area.
 - Antarctic Specially Protected Area (ASP)
Entry is prohibited without a permit. All activities must be in accordance with the management plan.
 - Snow Petrel breeding area
Please do not enter these areas as you may disturb nesting birds.
 - Mast

 - Transmit Mast, Antenna
