MAP RELIABILITY: Compiled in 1973 from aerial photography 1957, 1958, 1959 and 1960. Minor additions and amendments from 1973 helicopter photography.

MAP ACCURACY: The average accuracy of this map is ± 110 metres in the horizontal position of well defined details. Due to deficiencies in the mapping photography and related ground control, some topographic features are known to be out of position by up to 280 metres. Contour elevation errors in excess of 20 metres are known to exist in some areas. With the exception of those shown within the inset, all other topographical stations are symbolised for landmass value only as their surveyed coordinates do not necessarily agree with those indicated on this map.

NOMENCLATURE: Names have been approved by the Antarctic Names Committee of Australia.

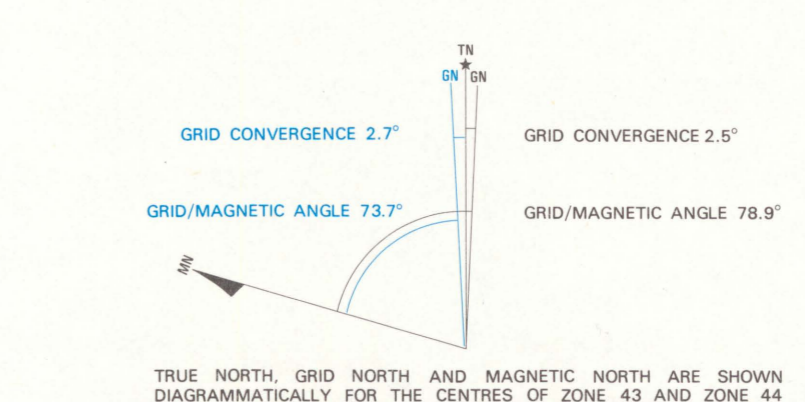
To convert height above the WGS72 spheroid obtained from Doppler satellite observations to heights above sea level, subtract 18 metres.
