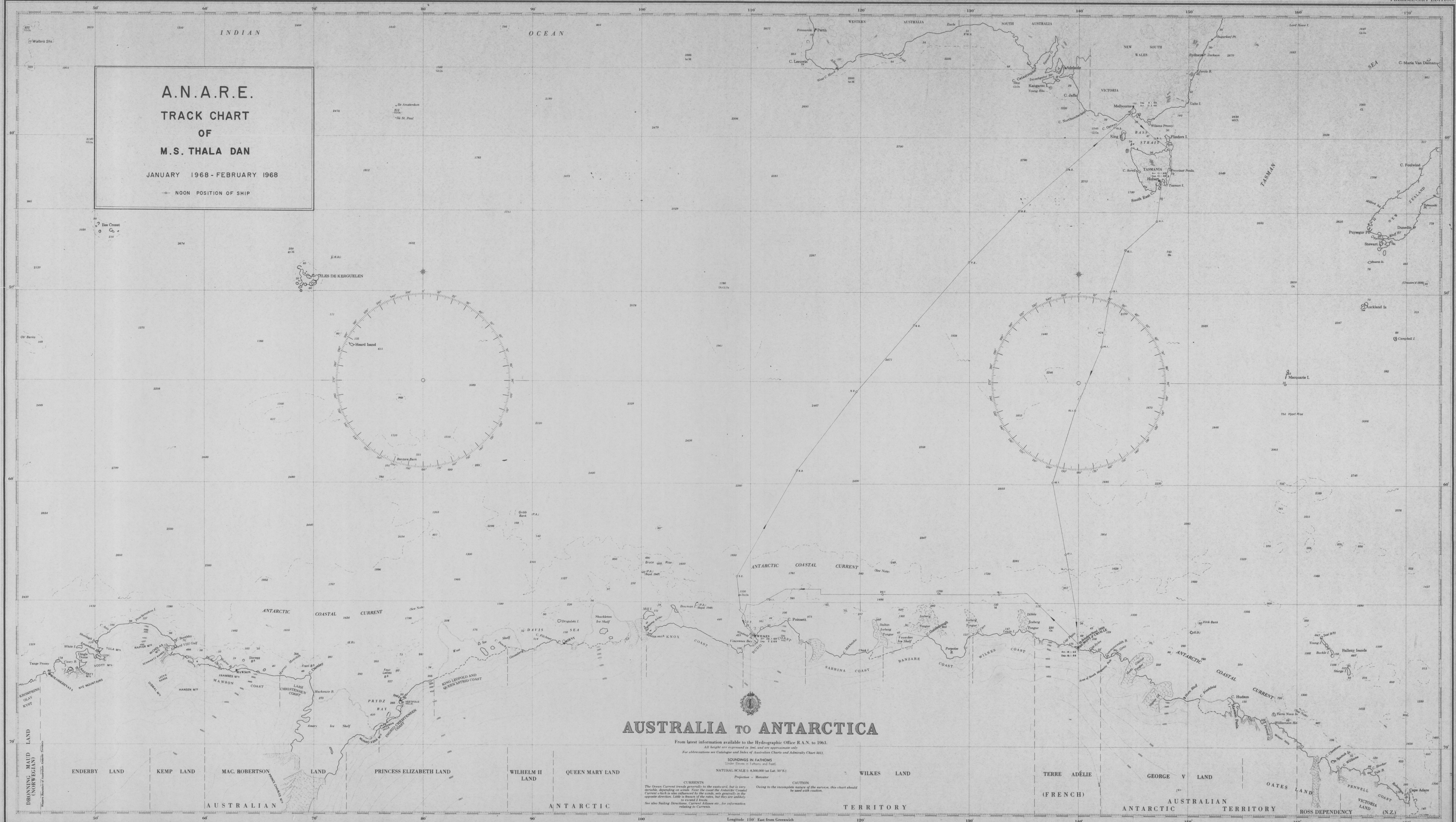


A.N.A.R.E. TRACK CHART OF M.S. THALA DAN

CURRENTS
The Ocean Current tends generally to the eastward, but is very variable, depending on winds. Near the coast the Antarctic Coastal Current is also influenced by the winds, sets generally to the opposite direction. Little is known of the rates, but they are unlikely to exceed 2 knots.
